Call to Order

Review Minutes of July Meeting

Finance Report

Minister's Report

Rod gave some details of his trip to Transylvania, and showed a few items he'd like to see framed for display on the Sanctuary walls.

Aesthetics Committee Report

Ellen Holt has done some research about a recent proposal for an outdoor flag and flagpole, also a "peace pole" (a resin sleeve for a wooden post that has "peace" or a saying in a number of languages on it). Both are proposed to be placed outside and to the right of the front door. Practical issues (costs, placement, maintenance) were discussed, as well as possibilities of an American flag, United Nations flag, or a "World" flag to be flown. There was discussion over these matters as well:

- 1. Flying the American flag outdoors might be controversial within the Fellowship.
- 2. If it was flown, that and a "World" flag might be more appropriate to our principles.
- 3. What would flying the U.S. flag and a "World" flag mean to the public passing by that would see them? To the military members of our community?
- 4. What message do we as the Fellowship get from flags such as these?

It was agreed that a device to invite opinion would be developed to start a dialogue within the Fellowship.

<u>RE Status</u>

It was reported that Debbie and Darrell Bruning, as co-DREs, are in transition, and that Sandy Urbanczyk's last day is August 28th.

News on the progress of the fence project was that Briggs had made a template for its construction, and that choices of play equipment were being considered.
